Spotlight on Lebanon Rotary

Lebanon Rotary recently recognized Kevin Allen, Patti Brayfield, Angie Wright, Matt Wright, Nick Mebruer, Susan Mott, Jared Carr, Bob O'Neil, Steve Hite and Beverly Miller (also J. Kenneth Carr posthumously) as new Paul Harris Fellows.

Donald Allen, Hugh Vic Corry, Joy Davis, Richard Hobbs, Steve Pickering, John W. Reese and Vic Slaughter were recognized as new Paul Harris Fellows +1. Lebanon Rotary has a total of 27 'Plus One' Paul Harris Fellows.

Of the current membership of 119, 50 members are Paul Harris Fellows. There are currently 2 Benefactors in the club. To date 66 of the members are TRF Sustaining members.

A \$2,500 Polio Plus donation was presented which when matched with \$1,250 from TRF World Fund and further matched with \$7,500 from the Gates Foundation results in \$11,250 which will purchase vaccine to immunize 18,750 children.

250 'Coats for Kids' were gathered and distributed.
